Mr. Philibosian currently serves as a Board Member of Mack Cali Realty Corporation (CLI), a national real estate investment trust, listed on the New York Stock Exchange. He currently serves as a member of the Executive Compensation and Option Committee (of which he previously served as Chairman) and is a member of the Nominating Committee.

He previously served as counsel to the Haworth Planning Board from 2002-2008. Mr. Philibosian currently serves as a member of the Board of Directors and Budget Finance, and Endowment Committees of the Armenian Missionary Association of America in Paramus, New Jersey, and also serves as a member on the Board of Elders of the Armenian Presbyterian Church in Paramus New Jersey.
